LIHEAP PROGRAM

The LIHEAP Energy Assistance Program provides assistance for income eligible families and individuals with their electric, gas or propane bill. They also provide emergency assistance for individuals and families who are at risk of having their electricity disconnected. The following documentation is required at time of application for LIHEAP services:

- Gross income for all household members
- Social Security cards for all members of the household
- A print out from the utility company showing annual usage
- Head of household government ID (ex. Drivers License)

FAMILY RESOURCE CENTER

The Family Resource Center benevolence fund provides income eligible families assistance with their electric bills. Criteria to be eligible for the Family Resource Center benevolence fund include but are not limited to:

- Have at least one child enrolled in the Henry County School System (Lakewood, Henry, Harrelson, Grove or Henry County High School)
- Have a referral from the school
- Meet income eligibility requirements
