Trees beautify our neighborhoods and when planted in the right spot, they can even help lower your energy bills. But the wrong tree in the wrong place can be a hazard...especially to power lines.

LARGE TREES

Height/spread of more than 40 ft. Such as:

- Maple
- Birch
- Oak
- Sweetgum
- Spruce
- Linden
- Pine

MEDIUM TREES

Height/spread of 25 to 40 ft. Such as:

- Washington Hawthorn
- Golden Rain Tree
- Eastern Redbud
- American Arborvitae
- Dogwood

SMALL TREES

Height/spread of no more than 25 ft. Such as:

- Star Magnolia
- Crab-apple
- Lilac

*Avoid planting within 20 ft. of power lines.
When planting within 20 ft. is unavoidable,
only plant small shrubs and trees.*

Maximum tree height 25 ft.
