Why shouldn't I put fats, oils and grease down the drain?

Fats, oils, and grease (FOG) can cling to the inside of sewer pipes when washed down kitchen drains. Over time, this buildup may block pipes, leading to backups in kitchens or overflows on private property and streets. These issues can result in property damage, environmental harm, and health hazards.

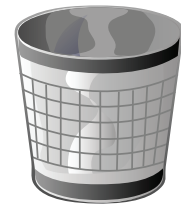
What should I do with fats, oils and grease instead?
